Why did they wave palm branches and shout "Hosanna?"

In Jesus' day, the waving of the Palm branches symbolized great victory and celebration. According to Jewish tradition, when Simon the Maccabee recaptured Jerusalem from the Syrians, they "entered it with praise and palm branches." So when Jesus was making His way into Jerusalem, He was met with a welcome that was deserved for a victorious king, which He is.

Hosanna, a term of acclamation or praise, transliterates a Hebrew word that literally means, "Help, I pray," or "Save now, I pray." When Jesus was coming into Jerusalem, they were acknowledging Him as the King who has come to save His people. Let us remember on this Palm Sunday that Jesus is the King of Kings who has come to save His people from their sin and He is worthy to be praised.

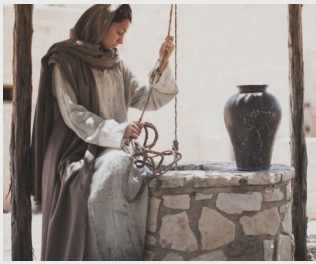
