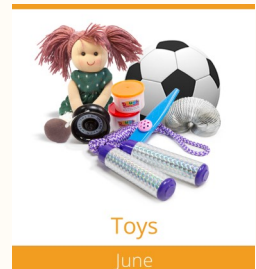

The event immediately follows and features speaker **Scott Dawson** and Christian musician and singer and songwriter **Zach Williams.**

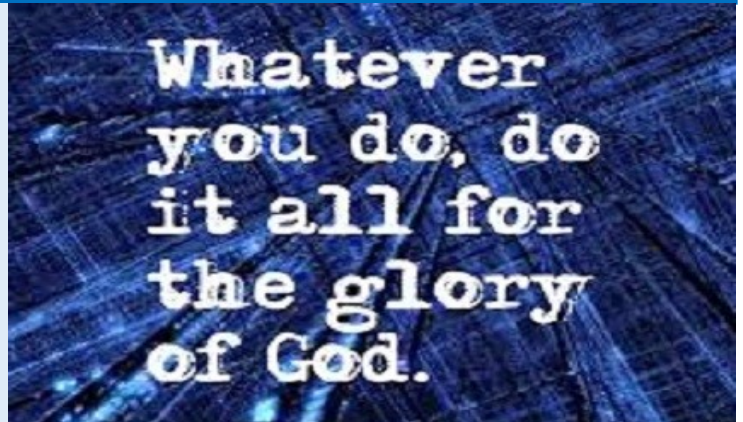

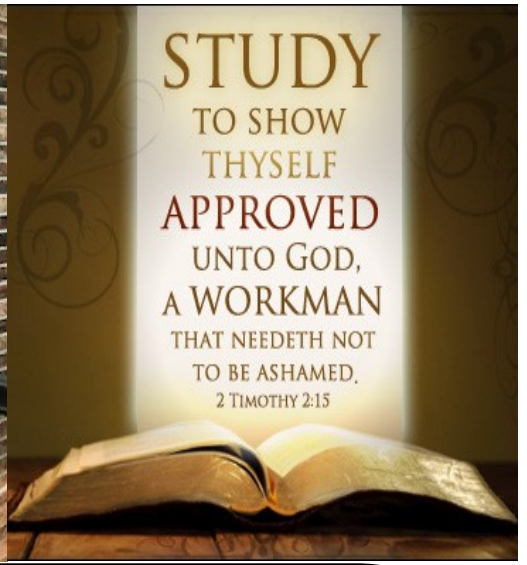
