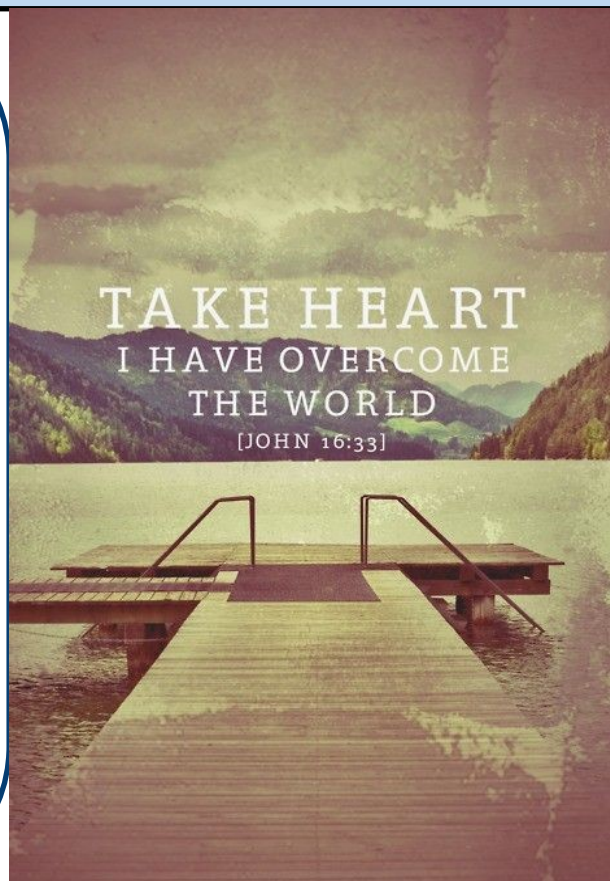
6:00 PM vs Orioles
