

Thank you to the FBC Choir who blessed us once again with a beautiful Christmas performance. The singing was magnificent, and the vignettes were spectacular. Can't wait until next year to see how you top this!

A note of thanks from Debbie Barb:

Larry had surgery October 21 to clear 90% blockage of carotid artery on right side. Surgery was successful and he has healed very well. Still has some numbness at site but were told that should improve with time. After his surgery in June for pacemaker/ defibrillator, it was found that he was having what they called "extra premature heartbeats" before regular heartbeat which was making his heart work harder--thought he might have to have a procedure to try to take care of that issue. He wore a heart monitor for 14 days in October to see how those heartbeats were registering now. We had tele-computer conference yesterday with the surgeon about the results. In June, those extra heartbeats were happening 20% of the time which was concerning to the doctor. He said that the monitor showed that number is now down to 8%. YAY, good news! Music to our ears. At this time, don't have to do anything further. Will do another heart monitor in three months and see how things are then...
