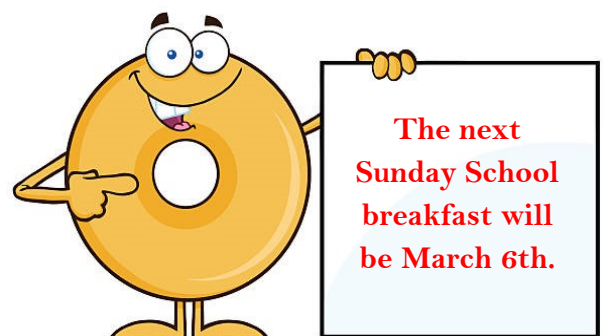
Dear FBC family,

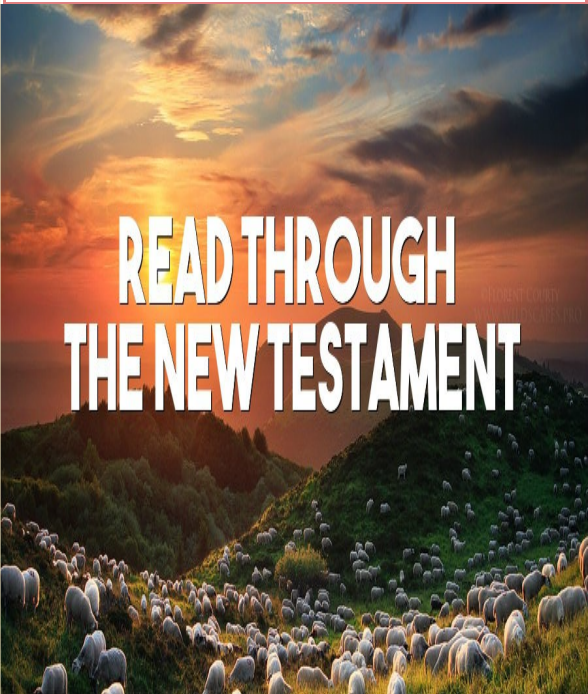
