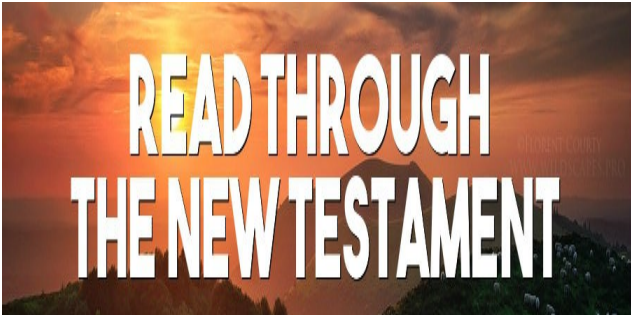

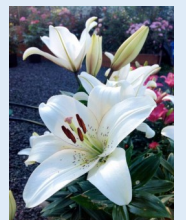

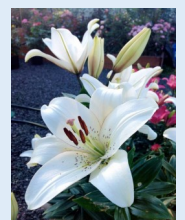
Our sincere sympathies go to the family of JR Fannon who died February 24, 2022. His mother Anna used to attend FBC, Windsor.
