Dear FBC family,

What exactly is Palm Sunday? Palm Sunday is a celebration of when Jesus made His triumphal entry into Jerusalem before the feast of Passover. John gives us an account of this event; "The next day the large crowd that had come to the feast heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem. So they took branches of palm trees and went out to meet him, crying out, "Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord, even the King of Israel!" And Jesus found a young donkey and sat on it, just as it is written, "Fear not, daughter of Zion; behold, your king is coming, sitting on a donkey's colt!" (John 12:12-15 ESV).

The Jews believed that the rightful heir to David's throne would be a conquering King who would come and overthrow their enemies and reestablish their Kingdom. What the people failed to realize on that day was Jesus was not coming to conquer the Romans and to establish David's throne. Jesus was coming to defeat a powerful foe indeed, but this foe was not a worldly kingdom. Jesus came and died to overthrow the power of sin, death, hell, and the grave.

When Jesus returns, He will be coming as the conquering King who will establish His Kingdom for all eternity.


Wednesday, June 1, 2022, 6:00 PM...Family Worship begins and goes throughout the summer.
