Dear FBC family,

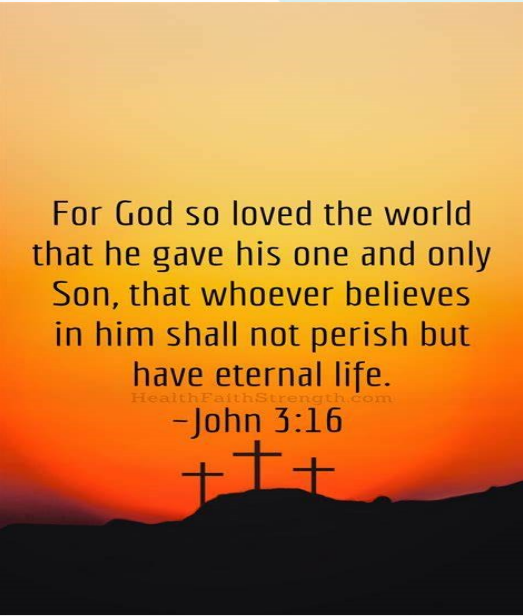

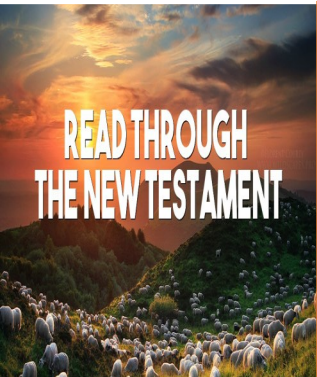
