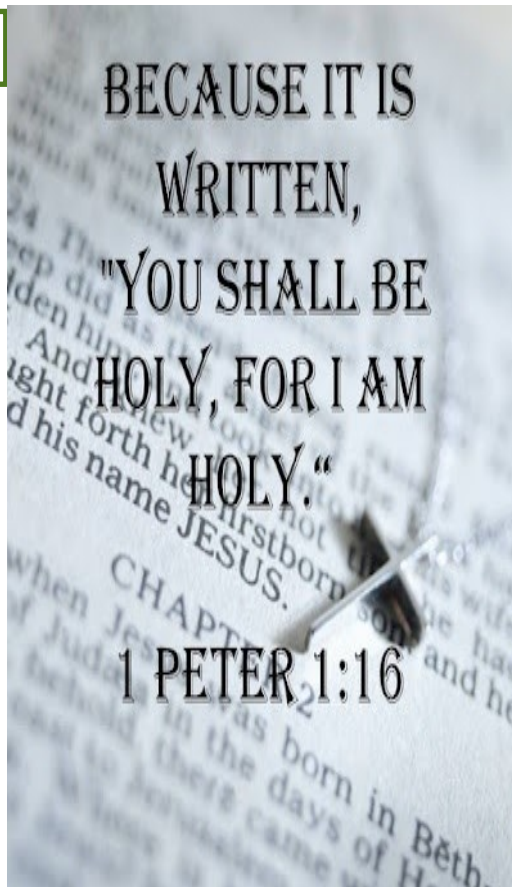

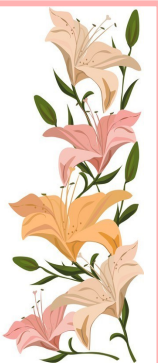
## **Summer Lunch Program needs more volunteers!**
