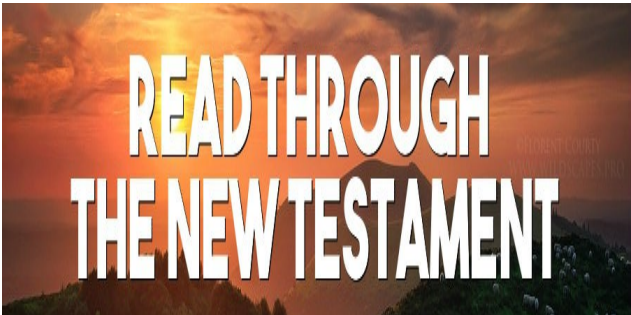

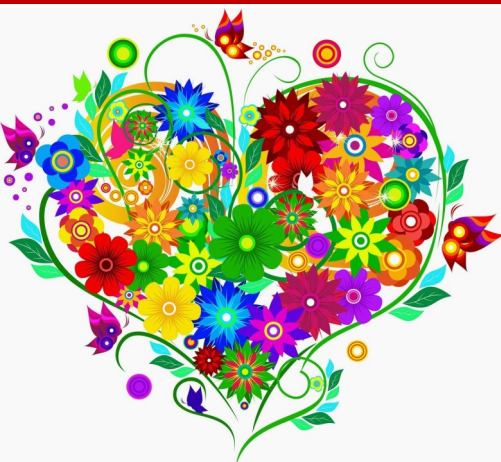


To the First Baptist Church,
