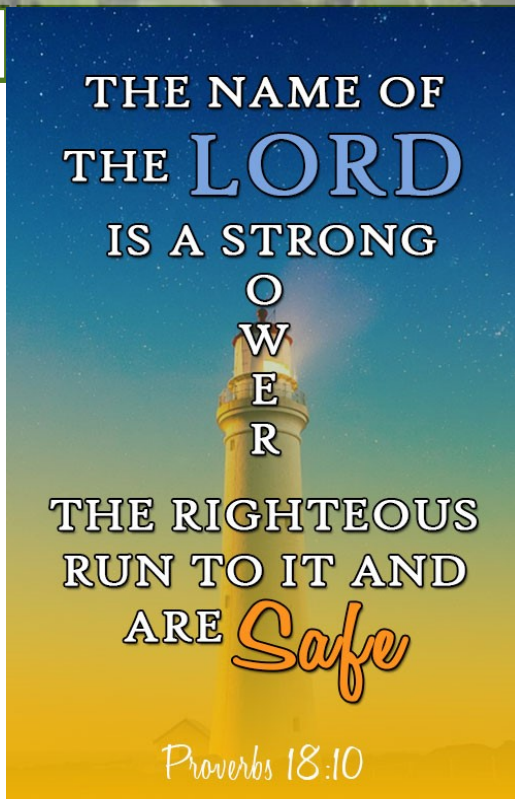

Dear FBC family,

Psalm 119 is one of the most neglected passages of Scriptures in the Bible due to its length. However, this Psalm is an outpouring of a love of the law by the Psalmist. This is an “alphabetic psalm” of a more stringent character than any other. It consists of twenty-two stanzas, each of eight verses, every verse in each stanza beginning with its own proper letter—those of stanza 1 with aleph, the first letter of the Hebrew alphabet, those of stanza 2 with beth, the second letter; and so on. May the Lord give us the same rich love for His Word.
