Dear FBC family,

This group of verses is another section of lament by the psalmist. Eric Lan provides great insight into this beautiful passage of Scripture. "This tells us how he feels about the alien society he lives in. It gives him grief and sorrow (vv. 25, 28), causes him heart-searching (v. 26) and moves him to prayer (vv. 25b, 26b, 27a, 28b, 29, 31b). Whether he realizes it or not, his prayer is already being answered, for his resolution to be faithful is strengthened (vv. 30-32)."

May we possess the same attitude as the Psalmist and realize that we are daily becoming more alien in our society. May we be a people who pray, with a broken heart, over the condition of our land.

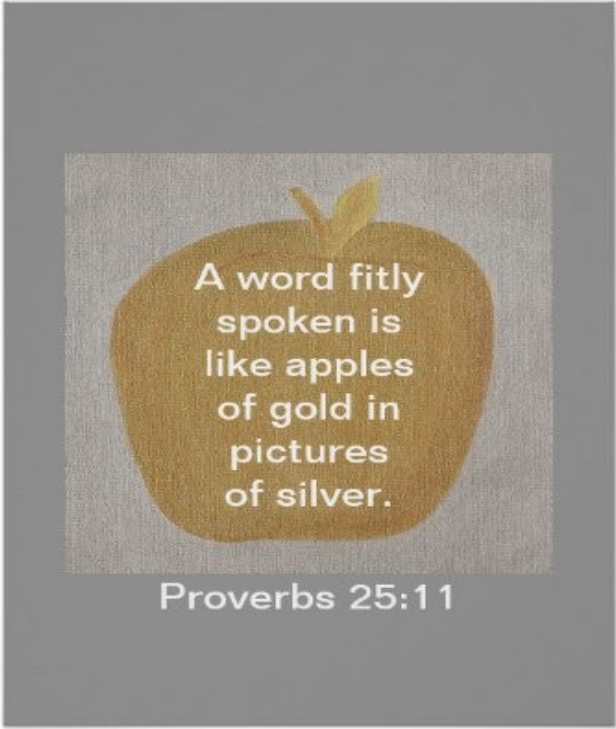

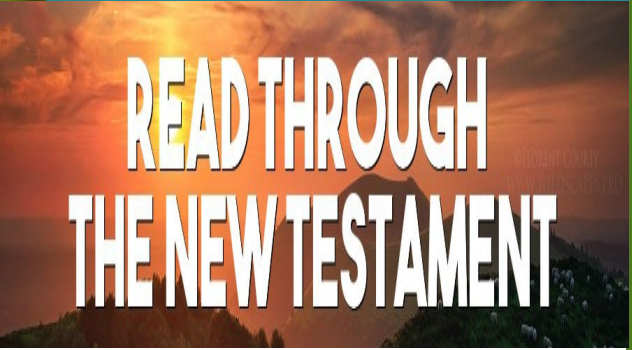
