This section of Psalm 119 focuses on the love that God has for His people and the love that is reciprocated back to the Lord by them.

Those who have experienced the “steadfast love” of God have confidence when they are faced with mocking because “for I trust in your word.” (v.41) and “for my hope is in your rules.” (v.42).

Being faithful to the word of God brings about freedom, or as the Psalmist states, “I shall walk in a wide place.”

As this Psalm progresses, the love that the writer has for the Word of God becomes more evident. I pray that we, as a church, would have the same love for the Word of God as well.

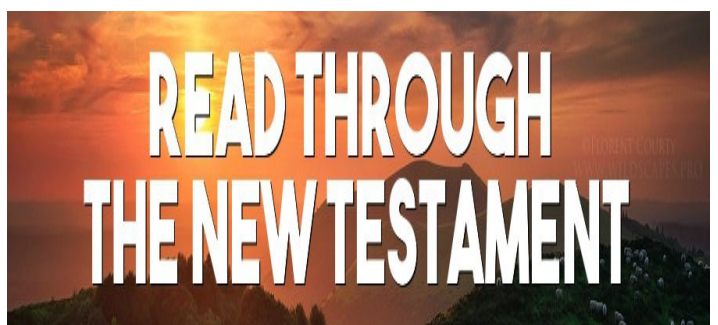

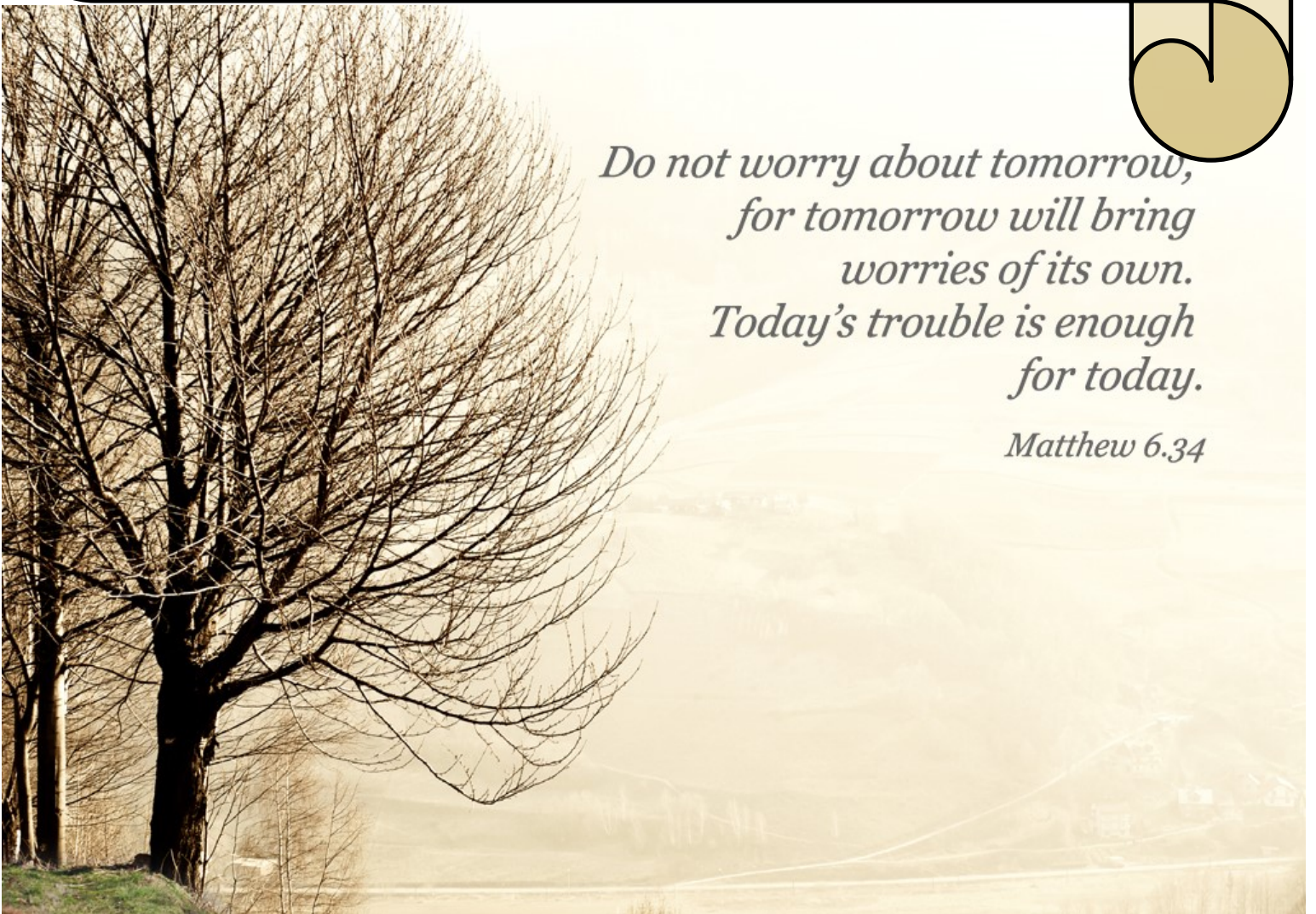
