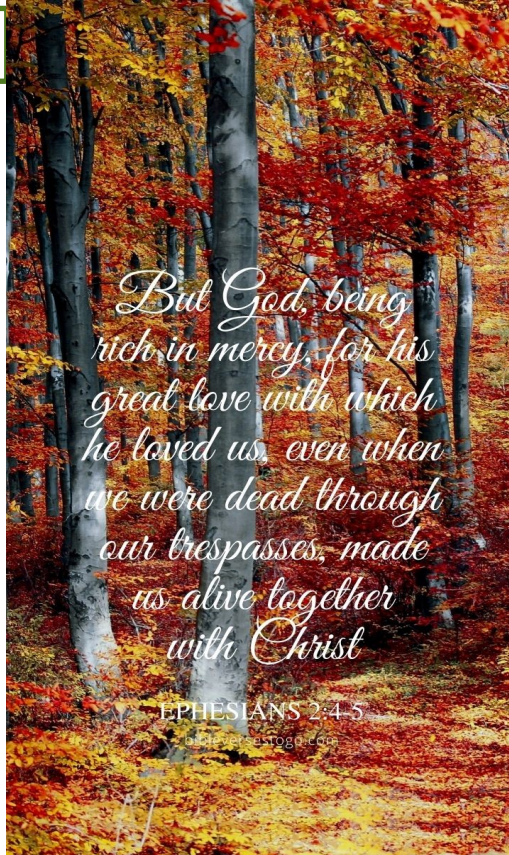

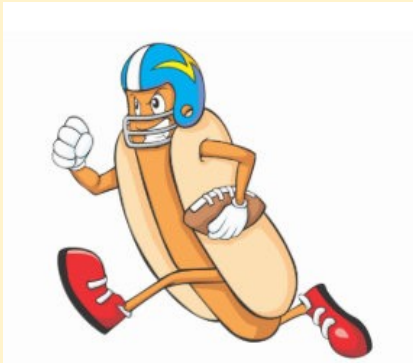

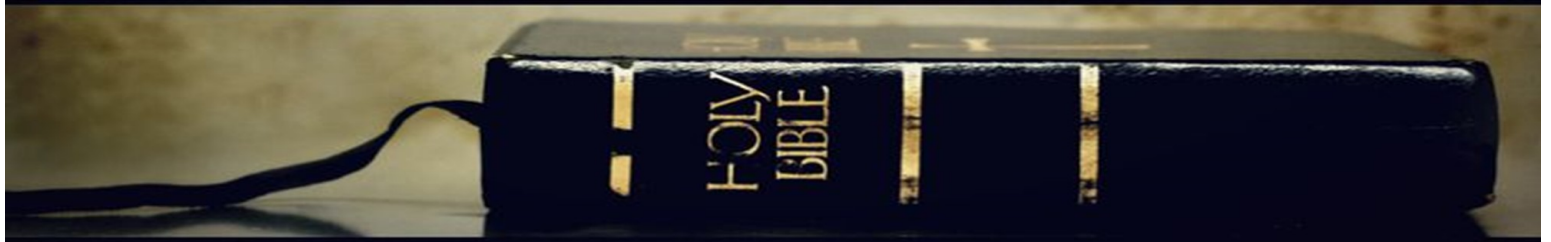
Take home a coffee cup, fill it up with your pocket change, and bring it back anytime or even multiple times in October.
