for I keep your precepts.

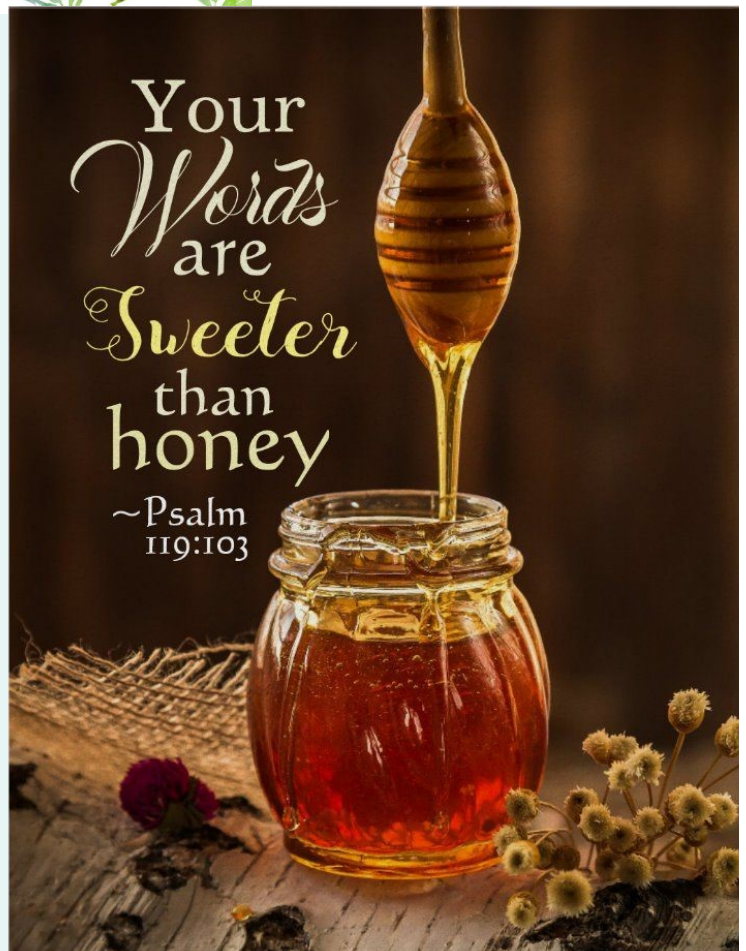

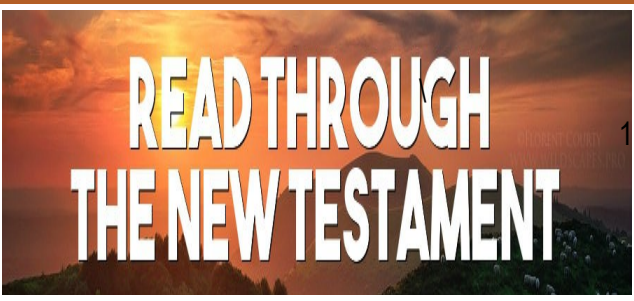
