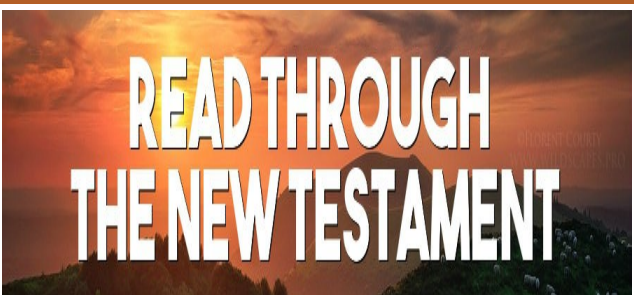

We have NO MORE overstock in these items to get us through the winter months. If you have anything you're not using, we'd be grateful.

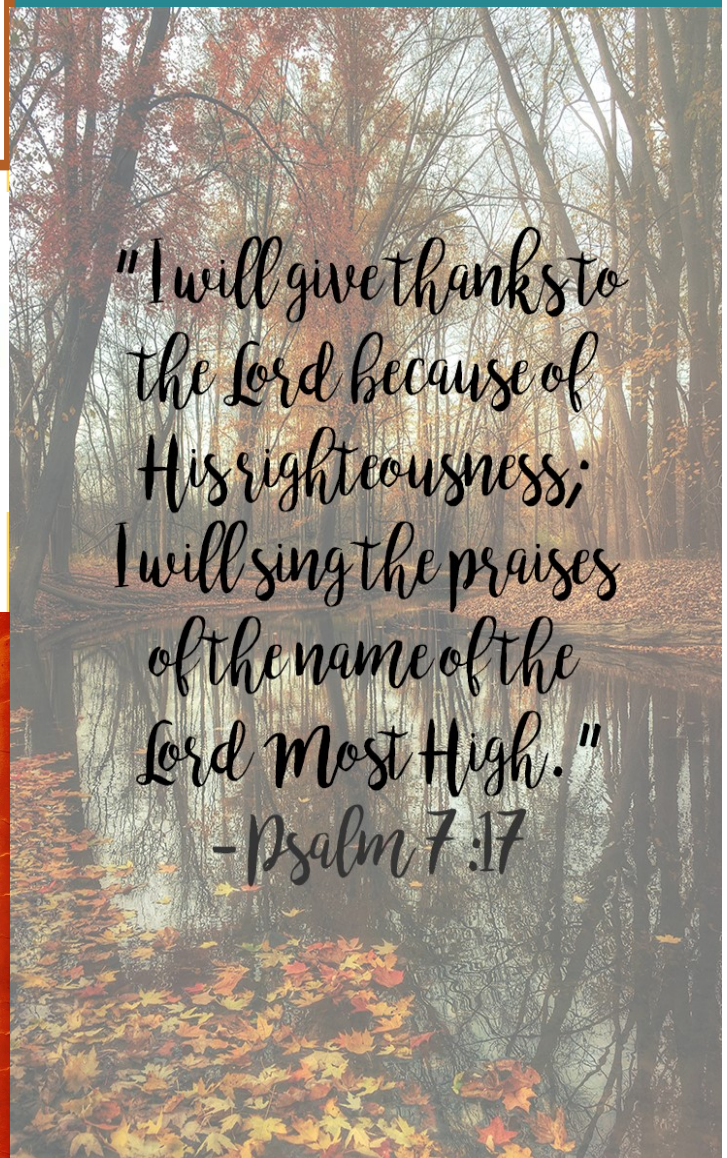
