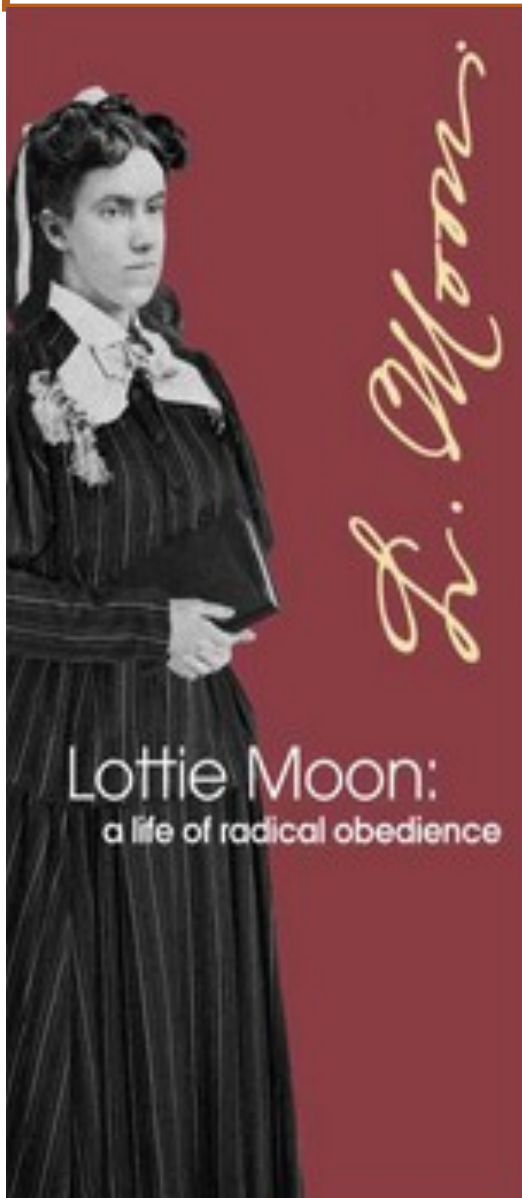

**READ THROUGH
THE NEW TESTAMENT**



The past few months in Mission Mosaics magazine, the director of the WMU, Sandy Wisdom-Martin, shared a story about Anne Lucas, a former missionary kid who grew up in Nigeria. Anne described their life in a small town called Keffi, a place with average temperatures of 100 degrees or higher, and they had no running water or electricity for their first few years there. Her father spent quite a bit of time traveling with pastors into the bush country spreading the love of Jesus. There was one village quite a ways from Keffi that had never heard about Jesus and had a long history of pagan leadership. Travel to this village, however, would require many hours even by vehicle, so her family began to pray for a way to reach the village. Her father, when working on his missions budget, would always include funds to purchase a motorcycle, but it was routinely denied because funds through the Lottie Moon Christmas offering had not reached their goal, and there were more pressing needs. After several years of praying, Southern Baptists managed to exceed the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering goal for missions, and funds were available for a motorcycle. Talk about an answer to prayer! In honor of the source of the funds, the motorcycle was promptly named "Miss Lottie," and shortly after receiving the motorcycle, her father, and a local pastor loaded their supplies which included an accordion! After many hour of travelling through the jungle, they arrived at the remote village.
