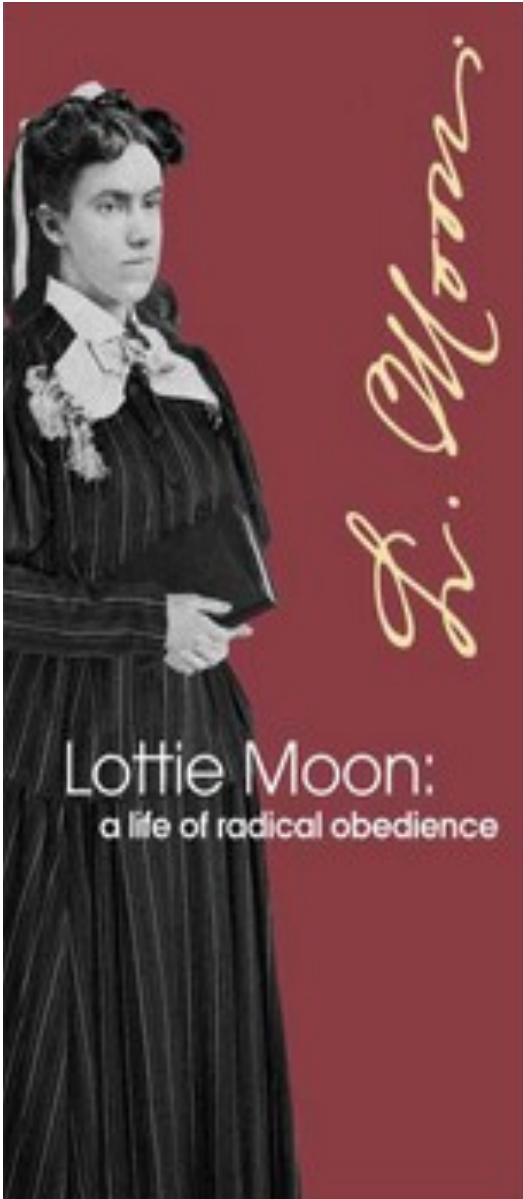

THE NEW TESTAMENT



Last week, you read about Anne Lucas, a former missionary kid who grew up in Nigeria. Her family prayed for many years for a motorcycle so that her father would be able to travel to remote villages with pastors to tell the villagers about Jesus. The needed funds arrived, and the motorcycle, which her father named "Miss Lottie," was loaded up with supplies and an accordion.

They finally arrived at the remote village. No one in the village had ever seen a white man. They'd never seen a motorcycle, and they'd never heard about Jesus until the her father told the story of God's love with the help of an interpreter. As Annie's father finished sharing, an elderly woman slowly walked toward him. She got very close to his face and pointed her finger at him. Her face showed how angry she was with him. She began explaining how she was the priestess of that village, and how her family had been priests and priestesses for many generations. She told how she traveled to various villages searching for na new god so that her family and village were worshipping the right gods. She explained how her people are afraid of their gods, and how they sacrifice goats, chickens, fruit to make them happy, but the sacrifices do not good; they do not work.

With her finger still pointed at her father, the old woman asked "What took you so long to come tell us about this man you call Jesus?" We are very angry that you were so slow to come!"

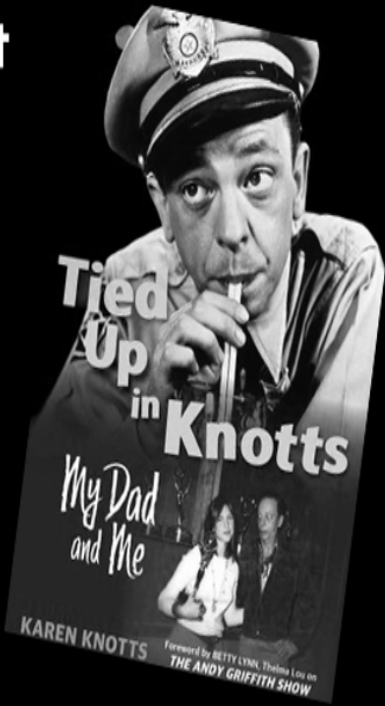
