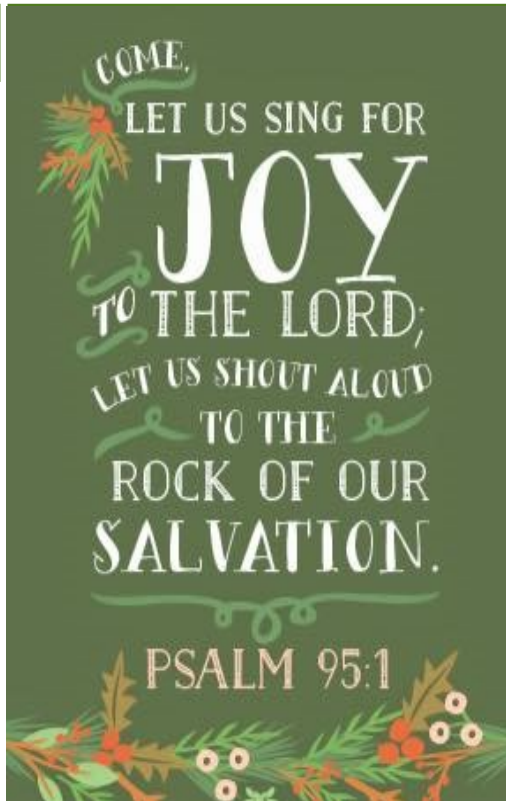

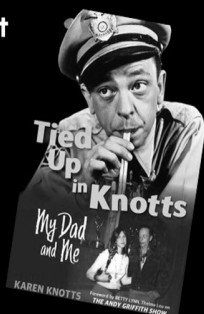

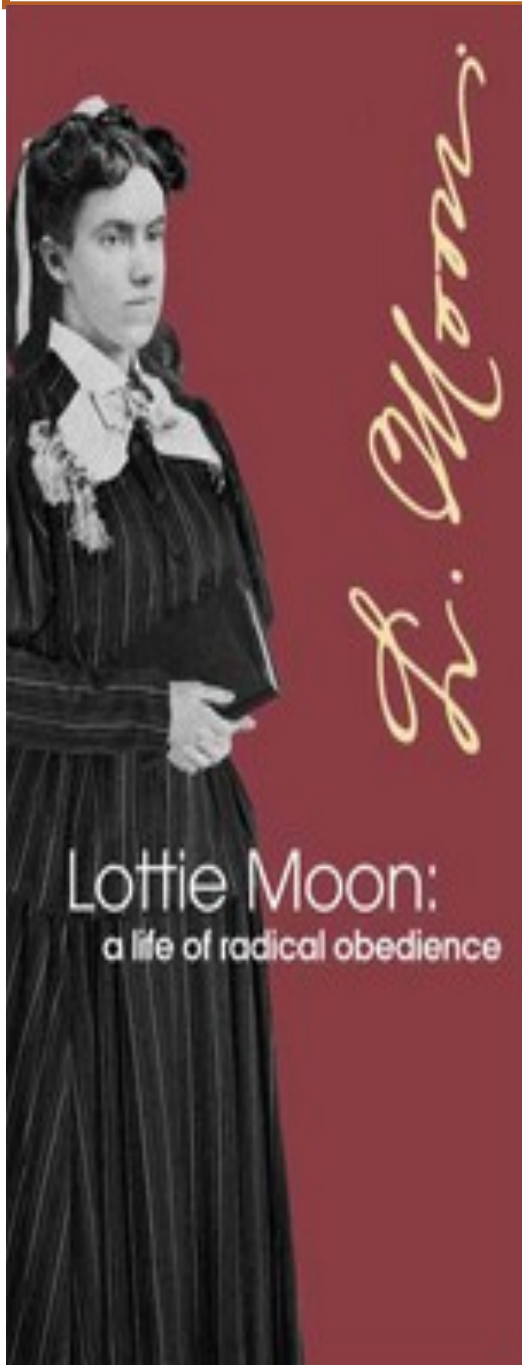

READ THROUGH THE NEW TESTAMENT



In the last two weeks, you've read about an experience that happened to the father of Anne Lucas, a missionary kid who grew up in Nigeria. Last week, you read that Anne's father had loaded up his motorcycle "Miss Lottie" and went with a pastor to a remote village who had never seen a white man or a motorcycle, and more importantly had never heard of God and his son Jesus. The priestess of the village was extremely angry at hearing the gospel, and confronted Anne's father about why it had taken them so long to get to her with that news as she had been unhappy with her pagan gods and their inability to help her family and her village even though they regularly offered sacrifices to them.

The priestess grabbed Anne's father by the arm and pulled him toward a hut with a thatched roof. Inside were dead animals and rotten food in front of several hundred idols stacked every which way in the hut. The stench was overwhelming! The priestess again informed the missionary that those gods had done nothing for her village. They prayed, begged, and sacrificed, but the gods do not care. "They do not love us...You tell us about a God of love who has existed since the beginning of time. What took you so long to come tell us this wonderful news?" asked the priestess.
