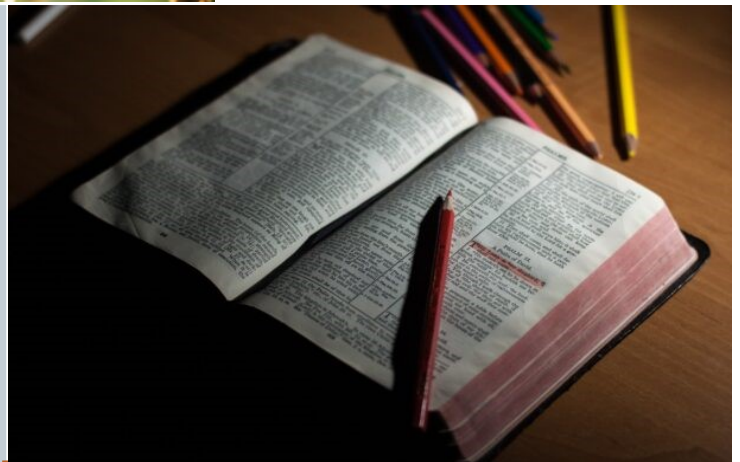
Dear FBC,
