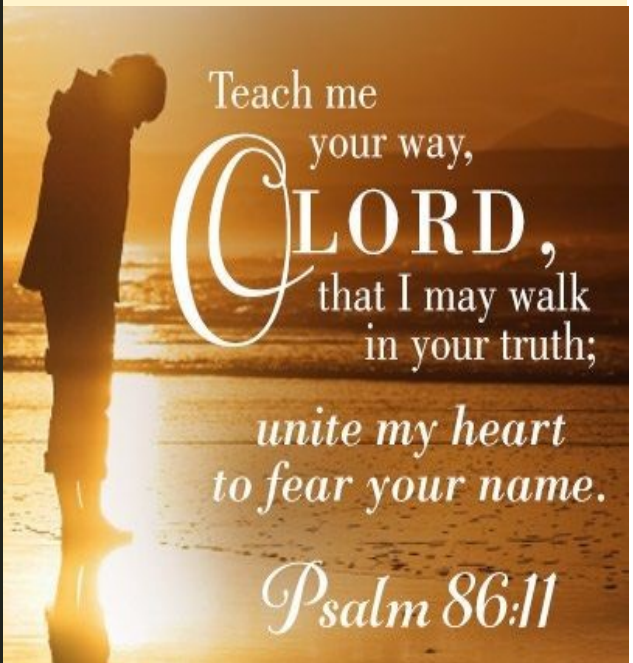

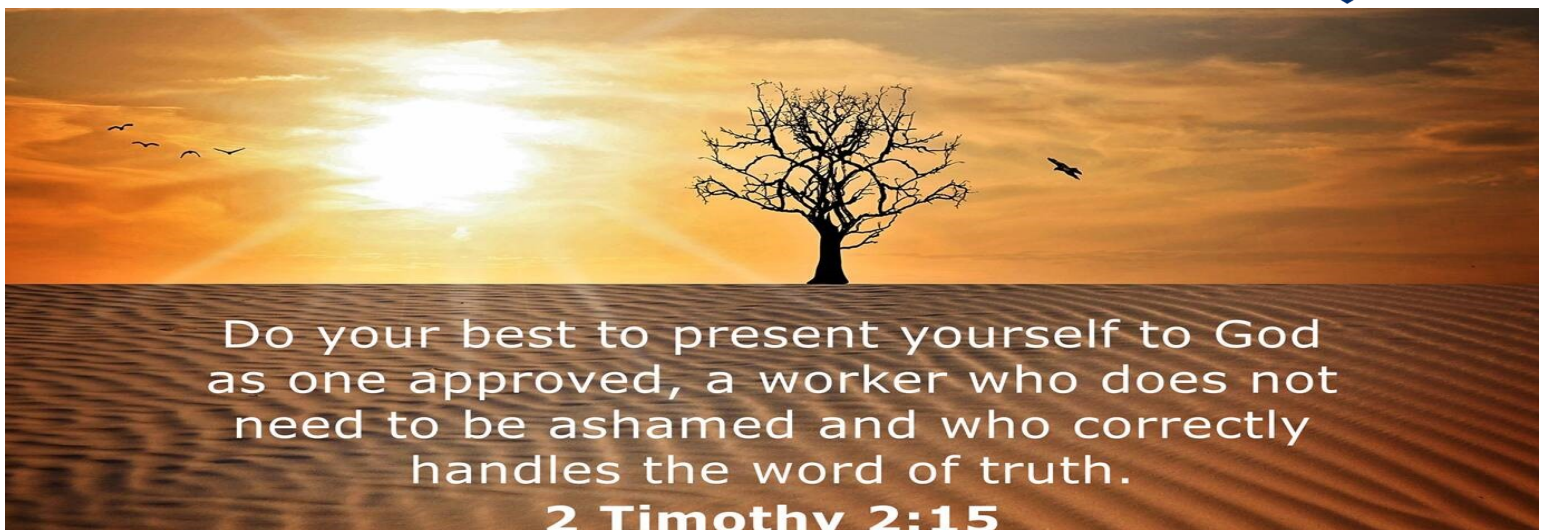
A special request...
