Information for Upcoming Deacon Election:

In accordance with the FBC Constitution, Section 1 Deacons, paragraph 3, "Deacons shall be elected annually by secret ballot. A man may be considered for nomination after he has been a member of this church at least one year. A deacon candidate must be nominated by five members of the congregation for his name to be placed on the ballot."

In addition, a deacon candidate shall exhibit the character qualities of Acts 6:3 and 1 Timothy 3:8-13.

There is a need for <u>three</u> deacons to be elected. Names for a deacon candidate may be submitted in writing to the church office or placed in the offering plate on Sundays. Names will be received until **11 August 2025**.

A nominee who receives enough votes will be contacted prior to election to see if they are willing to serve or wish their name to be removed from consideration.

For those willing to serve, their names will be compiled, placed on a ballot, and presented to the church on **17 August 2025** for Deacon Election. The three men receiving the most votes, and agreeing to service as deacon, will be elected with service beginning on 1 September 2025 for a three-year period. If an ordination service is required, one will be scheduled at the earliest date.
