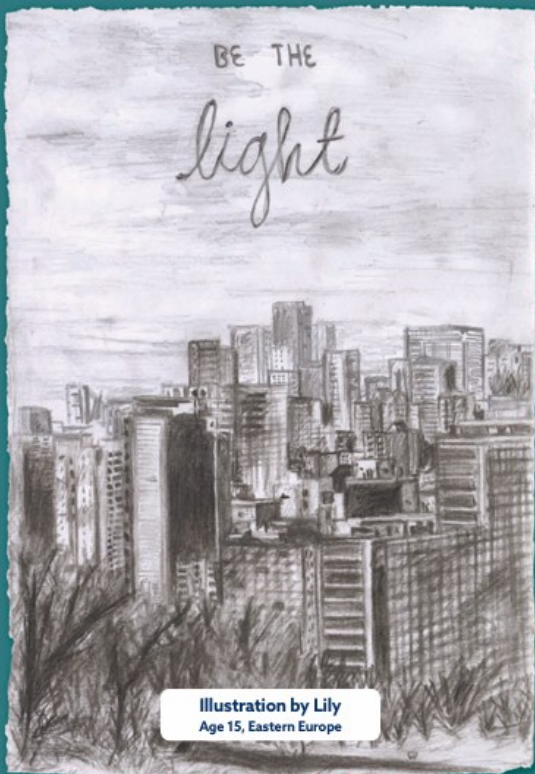

WHO IS LOTTIE MOON?
